7:10 ENROLLMENT and ACADEMIC REPORT: Traci Moore and Mustafa Ibrahim

Traci Moore reported that STEP Academy has a full enrollment and there is a waiting list for most grades. The literacy curriculum, Core Knowledge, for the elementary program has arrived and has been distributed to all of the elementary teachers. This curriculum was chosen because of its rigor, its integration of content information throughout, and its background knowledge coverage. A new math curriculum from Pearson will be used for grades K-6 and training for teachers will be next week. Final MCA scores for last year are: Math 41.8%, Reading 39.9%, and Science 51.2%. Changes for 2017-18 school year: realignment of RtI program for math and reading, additional reading class added for all seventh and eighth grade students, additional

science teacher for biology class. Positive Behavior Intervention Supports and ENVoY (classroom management) trainings for staff will be ongoing throughout the school year.

7:57 JUNE 2017 FINANCIAL REPORT: Tracey Fiereck and Mustafa Ibrahim

The June 2017 financials were examined. The school is in good viable position. A motion was made by Dr. Sandra to authorize Mustafa to negotiate a line of credit to handle temporary imbalances as the State adjusts to our K-12 expansion. Seconded by Deb Bartlett. Passed unanimously by all members present. A motion was made to approve the June 2017 financial report, it was seconded, and all present approved.
