Attendance continues to be strong at the elementary and secondary level. That being said, there have been several students who have reached the 15 day maximum number of absences set by MDE. Several phone calls and meetings have taken place prior to missing 15 days. With little sign of improvement, the behavior team will be entering into the next phase of interventions for these students.
